Where does New Zealand export dairy products to and why?

Use the 'New Zealand Dairy Global Business Factsheet' to identify the dairy products that New Zealand produces. Discuss the meaning of the terms import and export.

Complete a Wordle to see the most popular thoughts.

Import in this context means buying goods or materials from another country. Often this is because the country buying them can't produce them or can't produce enough of them. Export in this context means selling goods or materials to another country.

Predict which countries receive dairy products from New Zealand and give explanations for these predictions.

Ask do you think there are countries that New Zealand has stopped exporting dairy products to?

Do you think there are countries that are new export destinations for our dairy products? What could cause this to happen?

Explore the countries New Zealand exports to using 'Dairying around the world'. Which are the main countries we export dairy products to? Which dairy products do we export to which countries? Initiate discussion around why countries import products from other countries to support the students' thinking for the next task.

Choose a selection of New Zealand's export countries with a classmate. Locate these export countries on a world map. This should be a shared Google map, so the whole class is contributing to it. Find out which products we export to these countries using Dairying around the world. Discuss research and record possible reasons why these countries need to important dairy products from New Zealand.

Look for trends that might suggest why our export countries have imported more or less over time.

Ask why might the countries we export dairy products to change over time? Why might the type or quantity of dairy products these countries want to import change?

Share each group's work to generate a list of possible answers to these questions.

SUCCESS CRITERIA

Students can check they have completed the task successfully by:

- Identifying the countries that we export dairy products to
- Explaining the reasons for those countries needing to import our products
- Demonstrating an understanding that New Zealand has lots of export partners and they change over time
