HISTORICAL FACTS ABOUT DAIRYING IN THE AUCKLAND REGION

Auckland City thrived as dairying and grazing for meat expanded over a huge hinterland. In the 19th century, small dairy farms were established in Takapuna, Albany, Birkenhead and Milford.

Meat and dairy products were processed in Auckland factories at Penrose and Otahuhu, and exported from its ports. Manager, Wesley Spragg, started the New Zealand Dairy Association by

converting a cheese and bacon factory at Pukekohe into a butter factory.
