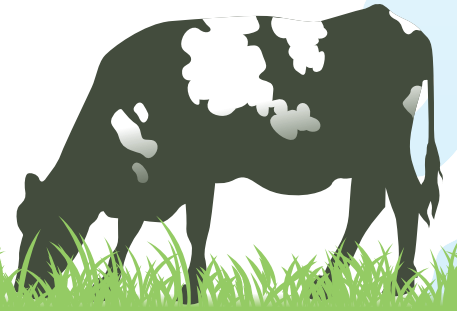


HOW TO MILK A COW
