Support students to complete the activities set out by theme of History, Geography and Community and Participation.

Investigate photos that demonstrate improvements in transport; demands of industrialisation; technological advancement; increase in suburban housing as a result of improved transport and economic cycles.

Use and explore the stories behind photos, videos and audio to investigate experiences for people from different areas and of different religions and ethnicities.
